An Italian painting Odyssey

In Venice light and water combine to create a restless magic. All borderlines are eradicated somewhere between dream and reality, present and past, the ethereal nature of this town has fascinated artists for centuries.

This is what Lesley has to say about it: "I love Venice. I have painted here year after year. I never tire of it; I'm always thrilled by it. I can walk down the same streets day after day, year after year, and there is always something new to take your breath away. I guarantee that this "Paint Venice Experience" will be exceptional in its genre...Venice can be very crowded, so part of the trick is to locate residential areas and to provide secluded vantage points for Grand Canal painting.

And there are some outer Venice islands that literally demand to be painted. I know where to board the vaporetto to get a front seat, so you can ride, ride, ride, and take photographs of the Grand Canal. Of course there is art all around you in Venice, in every church, on every building, around every corner. Venice IS art. Venice respects art. It is an experience every artist should have."

Lesley has reserved eight rooms in a Venice hotel for September 15 through September 25, 2010. It is a small hotel in the Dorsoduro region of Venice on a small canal that just happens to be a popular route with serenading gondoliers. The hotel is simple, very clean, and family-owned. It is a perfect painting location in the heart of Venice. The hotel has a terrace, "perfetto" for a small group of painters to get together at the end of the day.

WORKSHOP PRICE: \$1980
Deposit per person \$990 (space is limited to 15 students).

The balance of \$990 is due by June 11, 2010.

Package includes: Art instruction, 10 nights double occupancy accommodations, daily breakfast, and taxes.

You will arrive on Sept. 15 and you may begin painting then if you want. Formal instruction begins on Sept. 15. The last day of instruction is Sept. 24 with departure on Sept. 25.

Not included: Roundtrip airfare, ground transportation, lunches, dinners, drinks, admissions, paint supplies, and personal items.

Participants are responsible for their own flight arrangements.

A passport is required for travel to Italy. It must be valid at the time you return to your country of origin. A visa is not required for holders of a US passport.

A supply list suggesting materials will be available upon request.
